# REQUIREMENTS

'And We All Laugh' requires:

- A small square table (to hold the lard)
- A projector & screen that is linked to a sound system
- 1 microphone & 1 microphone stand

What I provide:

- Tarpaulin
- Plastic to protect the table provided
- 2 video files with sound
- Plastic bags and latex gloves (so it is easier to bag up the lard)
- Around 2/3 stones worth of lard
